11th August '22 Raksha Bandhan

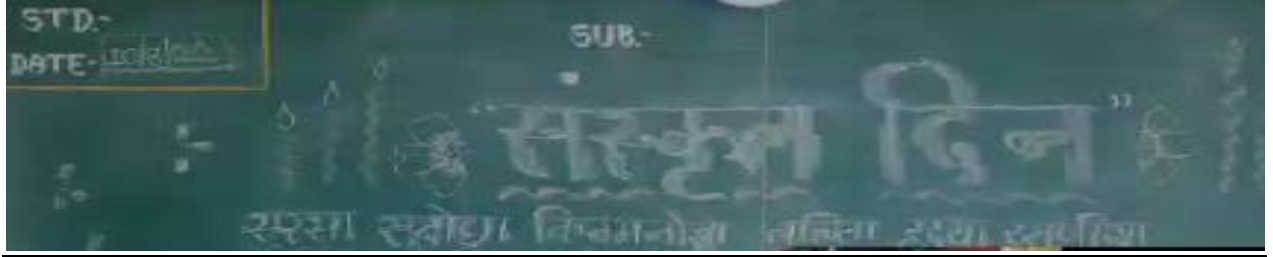


Bharati Vidyapeeth English Medium School Erandwane, Pune 38 celebrates Raksha Bandhan on 11th August '22 with great enthusiasm.

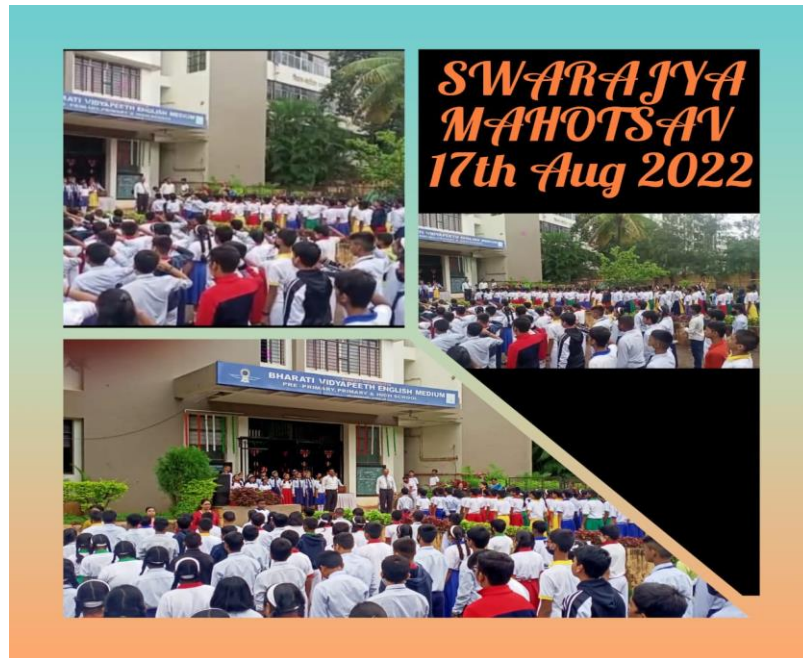
