19TH MAY :Result of annual examination was declared on online .Parents were informed on the WhatsApp .

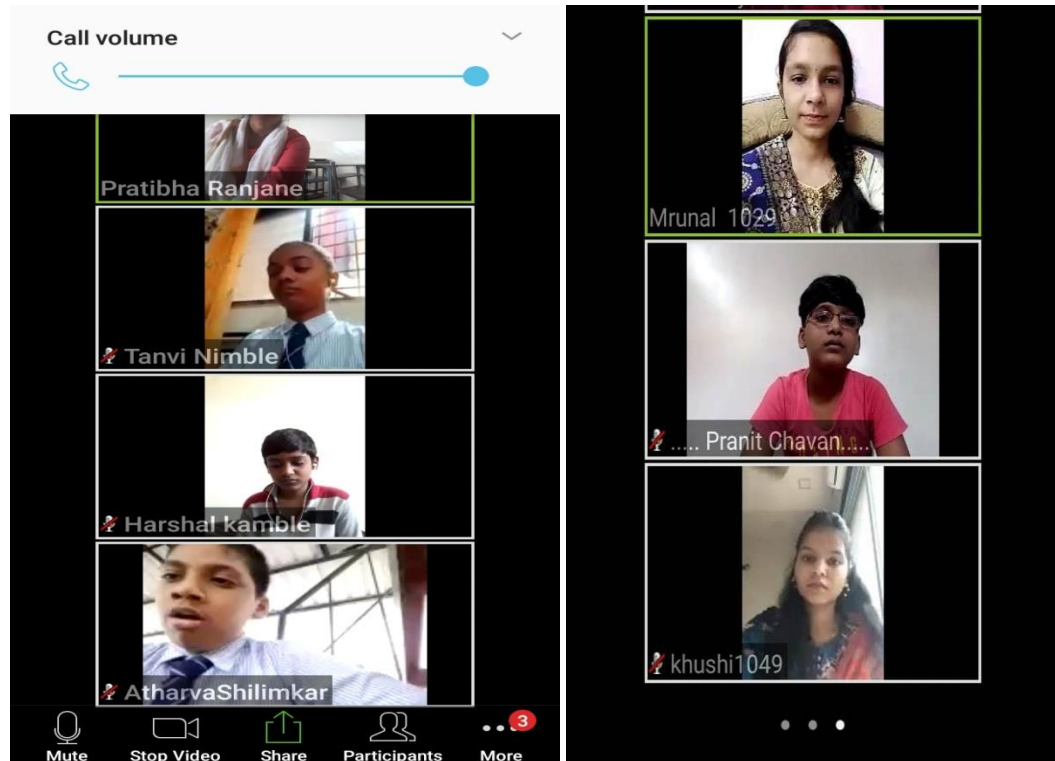
24th May to 30th May 2020 : Online Summer Camp

31ST JULY 2020 – Raksha Bandhan



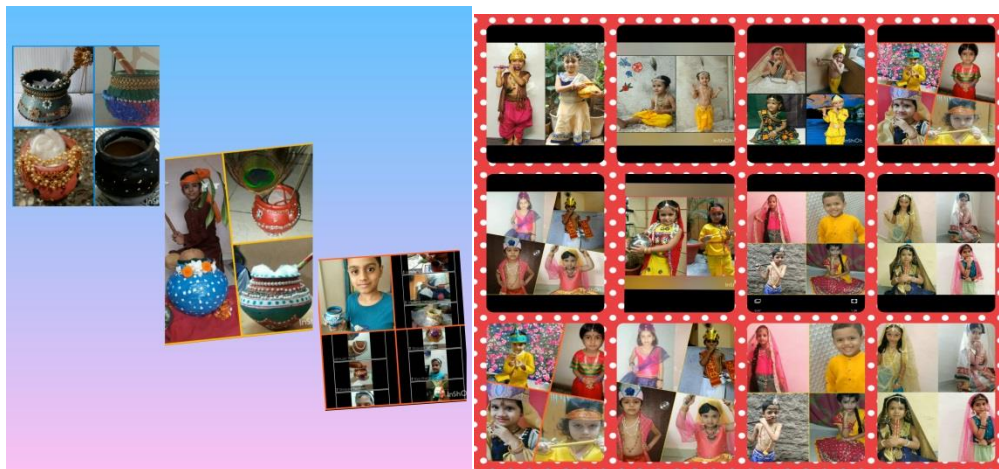

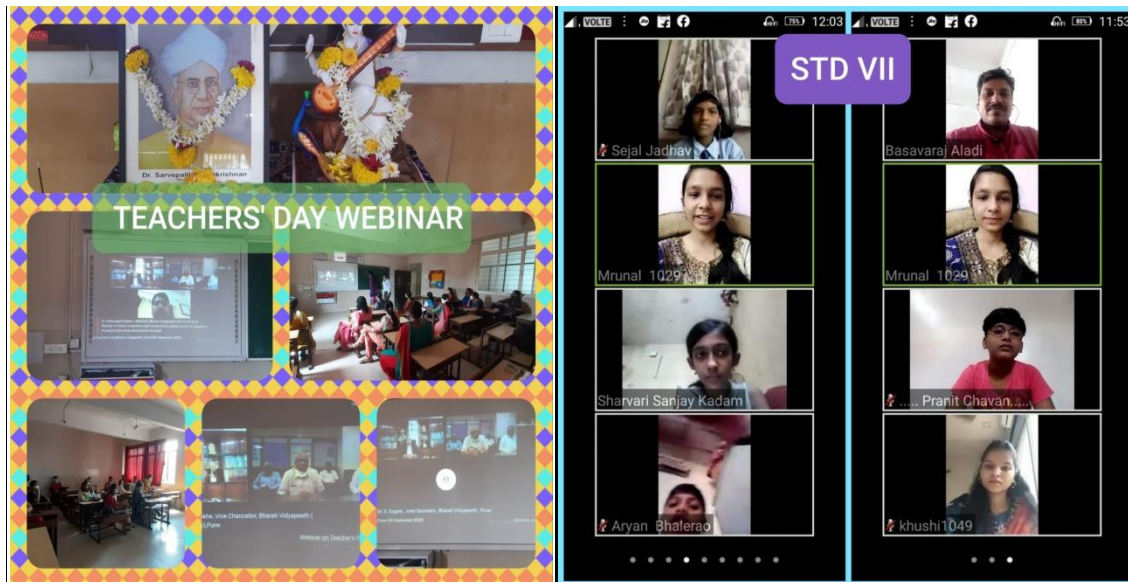
our students of standard VIII, IX,X celebrated this day by delivering speeches shlok stories dialogues in Sanskrit.
